You are invited to attend 2022 Special Olympics South Africa National Summer Games that will take place from the 16-20 November 2022 approximately 800 athletes will come together to compete in the 9 summer sporting codes at Old Peter Mokaba Stadium, Polokwane, Limpopo Province.

The proposed running of the event will be as follows:

- Wednesday, 16 November 2022- Delegates arrival
- Thursday, 17 November 2022- Divisioning and Opening ceremony
- Friday, 18 November 2022- Competitions
- Saturday, 19 November 2022- Competitions, Selection of National Team and Closing Ceremony
- Sunday, 20 November 2022- Delegates depart
- Health Screening of athletes will take place during the games

Athletes will be participating in the following sporting codes:

Athletics –Track & Field, Bocce, Football- 7 a-side, Male Football, 5-side Female football, (Equestrian and Golf taking place in Gauteng Province), Netball, Swimming, Table Tennis and Tin Pin Bowling. The selected team will part of the 2023 Special Olympics World Summer Games from 16 – 25 June 2023, Germany Berlin.
